Keynote Speaker

Sally P. Karioth, PhD, ARNP, RN is a Professor and the Director of Teaching Excellence at Florida State University in Tallahassee, Florida. She is also a gifted public speaker and acquired her gift from her varied experiences as a nurse, teacher, writer, talk-show hostess, and nationally renowned grief therapist. If one sentence characterizes the message of her speeches, it is her slogan: "Life is not a dress rehearsal." Karioth's presentations take her listeners on a rollicking ride through humorous anecdotes, somber insights, and helpful suggestions to cope with the dynamic stressors of education and healthcare. Some speakers make you laugh, some speakers make you cry, and some speakers can make you look at life differently. Karioth has the ability to do all three with her motivational messages on life. She has inspired numerous individuals in her path. Come let her inspire you to re-assess your own "footprints in the sand."

Debra Woda, DNP, APRN, CNM is a Clinical Associate Professor at The South Carolina College of Nursing in Columbia, South Carolina. She has been a nurse for over 33 years, making an enormous impact in the arena of women's health within both the clinical and educational settings. Woda served as a member of the DNP task force at The University of South Carolina and assisted in the development of an online DNP program which was implemented in the fall of 2008. She developed and now maintains the DNP virtual community, an online community for enhanced communication among students enrolled in the DNP program.
