Criteria for the Brother Ignatius Perkins Nursing Faculty Scholarship

The scholarship is being awarded in honor of Brother Ignatius Perkins who has served the citizens of the Commonwealth of Kentucky for many years through his activities for enhancing Nursing education. The scholarship is to be awarded annually as a one time only gift to qualified nurse applicants.

Criteria:

The minimum qualifications for the award are as follows: The applicants must have:

- 1 residency in the Commonwealth of Kentucky;
- 2 graduated from an accredited baccalaureate school of nursing;
- 3 hold an active license to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Kentucky;
- 4 hold current membership in the Kentucky League for Nursing;
- 5 been accepted into a graduate level program leading to a degree in Nursing at either the masters or doctoral level; and
- 6 the intention of remaining in the Commonwealth of Kentucky to teach in an undergraduate or graduate level program of nursing.

The scholarship will be awarded to a qualified applicant regardless of age, sex, race, religion, or political affiliation.

The applicant will prepare a 500-word essay in the form of a letter describing how he/she meets the criteria, a current transcript to demonstrate current GPA, and two letters of support.
