Pamela Jeffries, RN, DNS, FAAN, is Associate Professor and Associate Dean for Undergraduate Programs at Indiana University School of Nursing. Dr. Jeffries is currently the Project Director of a 3-year simulation study funded by the National League for Nursing and the Laerdal Corporation developing a theoretically-based simulation framework supporting the use of simulations in nursing curricula. Dr. Jeffries' research focus, in addition to simulations has been in online learning development, implementation, and evaluation, innovative teaching strategies, and learning outcomes associated with these innovative strategies.



Carolyn K. Lewis, PhD, RN, CNAA, BC, is Associate Professor and Assistant Dean of the Nursing Division for Bluegrass Community and Technical College, Lexington, Kentucky and is Principal of the P.R.I.N.E., LLC. She is the former Executive Director of the American Nurses Credentialing Center, subsidiary of the American Nurses Association. Dr. Lewis has served on many national boards and was appointed as a Virginia Commonwealth Fellow by the Council of Higher Education. She was awarded two significant state grants in 2003-2005 to develop a Public Health Nurses Leadership Scholars Program and further served as a "Leader Mentor" for the Kentucky Public Health Leadership Institute. She has been awarded 2.6 million in federal funds to expand the nursing programs at Bluegrass Community and Technical College.
