The following guidelines have been established by the ALN to assist organizations/agencies in the selection of Lamplighter Award recipients.

PURPOSES:

The purposes of the ALN Lamplighter Award Program are:

1. To recognize outstanding individuals who have demonstrated exemplary performance in the nursing profession or individuals who have made a substantial contribution to the cause of securing a better society.
2. To support programs of the Alabama League for Nursing.

ELIGIBILITY:

Any registered nurse, nursing student, or other individual who supports the ideals of the ALN is eligible.

SELECTION:

Selection of recipients will be based on criteria established by ALN.

CRITERIA:

The following criteria were established by ALN:

1. Display evidence of high professional/ethical standards.
2. Exemplify leadership qualities.
3. Consistently demonstrate a caring attitude in delivering quality nursing care/health care to the citizens of Alabama.
4. Display support for the development and improvement of teaching, research, and service programs in nursing.
5. Provide for the development of studies, projects, and/or programs designed to impact on the quality of life.

Lamplighter plaque and pin.
