Directions to Pleasant Valley Country Club:

From Boston: via MassPike/Route 90 West. To Exit 10A. Exit onto Route 146 South (Providence). 4 miles to Northbridge/Oxford exit, right onto Armsby Road at Pleasant Valley sign. Approximate travel time is 45 minutes.

From Points North: via Route 495. Take 495 South to I-290 West (Worcester). Take exit 12 onto Route 146 South (Brosnihan Square). 7 miles to Northbridge/Oxford Exit, right onto Armsby Road at Pleasant Valley sign.

From Points South: Via Route 495. Take 495 North to Route 16 (Milford). Follow through Milford Center and then through Uxbridge Center to Route 146 North. At the lights at Boston Rd Intersection (Mobil Station on right, Sutton Square on left) reverse direction onto Route 146 South. ½ mile to Northbridge/Oxford Exit, right onto Armsby Road at Pleasant Valley sign.

From Springfield & Points West: via Mass. Pike/Route 90 East. To Exit 10A (Worcester/Millbury). Exit onto Route 146 South (Providence). 4 miles to Northbridge/Oxford exit, right onto Armsby Road at Pleasant Valley sign. Approximate Travel time is 60 minutes.

From Worcester: via I-290 West. To Exit 12 (Brosnihan Square). Route 146 South. 7 miles to Northbridge/Oxford Exit, right onto Armsby Rd at Pleasant Valley sign. Approximate travel time is 15 minutes.

From Providence: via Route 95 North. To Route 146 North. At the lights at Boston Road Intersection (Just after the Central Turnpike exit, Mobil Station on right, Sutton Square on left) reverse direction onto Route 146 South. ½ mile to Northbridge/Oxford Exit, right onto Armsby Road .
