The PLN Awards Committee is seeking to honor those nurses who contribute to the Mission and Goals of the Pennsylvania League for Nursing, who carry on the traditions of revered past honorees and who exemplify the distinguishing criteria of the awards. PLN Awards will be presented at the Annual Conference to be held Spring 2007. The awards, their purpose and criteria are listed below. Nominations may be made on the official nomination form and returned to PLN Awards Committee by December 15, 2006.

Nursing Education Award: Licensed Practical Nursing Program

For excellence in teaching of nursing by a PLN member who is or has been a faculty member in an accredited Licensed Practical Nursing Program of Study. Award: Elegantly framed, specially designed certificate **Criteria for Eligibility:** The nominee is recognized for creative and inspirational interactions of students from diverse backgrounds; is a wise mentor of junior faculty; and, is a supportive colleague among peers.

Nursing Education Award: Nursing In-Service Training Program

For excellence in teaching of nursing by a PLN member who is or has been a member of a staff nursing in-service education program or department in hospitals, industry, public health or other agencies. Award: Elegantly framed, specially designed certificate. **Criteria for Eligibility:** The nominee is active in the field of nursing; furthers frontiers of knowledge in nursing education; exemplifies creativity in theory and practice; demonstrates a pioneering spirit

Nursing Education Award: Associate Degree Nursing Program

For excellence in teaching of nursing by a PLN member who is or has been a faculty member in an accredited Associate Degree Nursing Program of Study. Award: Elegantly framed and specially designed certificate **Criteria for Eligibility:** The nominee has made a significant contribution to teaching the nursing content in his/her field; is a scholar in his/her area of nursing instruction; is able to inspire and motivate students to a high level of competence; fosters in students an attitude of professional commitment to meeting the healthcare needs of diverse populations; and promotes independent functioning and independence

Nursing Education Award: Diploma Nursing Program

For excellence in teaching of nursing by a PLN member who is or has been a faculty member in an accredited Diploma Nursing Program of Study. Award: Elegantly framed and specially designed certificate **Criteria for Eligibility:** The nominee has made a significant contribution to teaching the nursing content in his/her field; is a scholar in his/her area of nursing instruction; is able to inspire and motivate students to a high level of competence; fosters in students an attitude of professional commitment to meeting the healthcare needs of diverse populations; and promotes independent functioning and independence

Nursing Education Award: Baccalaureate and Higher Degree Nursing Program

For excellence in teaching of nursing by a PLN member who is or has been a faculty member in an accredited Baccalaureate and Higher Degree Nursing Program of Study. Award: Elegantly framed and specially designed certificate. **Criteria for Eligibility:** The nominee influences scholarly development of nursing knowledge through creative approaches to nursing education; conducts and communicates research and evidenced-base nursing practice; advances nursing knowledge through theory development; and, has a history of recognized contributions that advance the science of the discipline of nursing
