New York Nursing Education in 2014

- 21,332 students were enrolled in nursing programs in 55 nursing schools that responded to 2014 NLN Biennial Survey of Schools of Nursing.¹
- 7,371 students graduated from nursing programs in 55 nursing schools that responded to 2014 NLN Biennial Survey of Schools of Nursing.¹
- 3,408 qualified applications to nursing programs were turned away from nursing schools in 55 nursing schools that responded to the NLN Biennial Survey of Schools of Nursing, due primarily to the following *two* reasons:¹
 - ❖ faculty shortage
 - ❖ other resource constraints

New York Nursing Workforce 2016

- 70,980 licensed PNs reside in New York.²
- 294,485 registered nurses are actively licensed in New York.²

In 2015, the New York state received Title VIII Grant of \$7,331,685.³
