

## VIRGINIA NURSE EDUCATION & WORKFORCE DATA

### Virginia Nursing Education in 2014

- 5,478 students were enrolled in nursing programs in 21 nursing schools that responded to 2014 NLN Biennial Survey of Schools of Nursing.<sup>1</sup>
- 1,982 students graduated from nursing programs in 21 nursing schools that responded to 2014 NLN Biennial Survey of Schools of Nursing.<sup>1</sup>
- 1,041 qualified applications to nursing programs were turned away from 21 nursing schools that responded to the NLN Biennial Survey of Schools of Nursing, due primarily to the following *two* reasons:<sup>1</sup>

- ❖ faculty shortage
- ❖ other resource constraints

### Virginia Nursing Workforce in 2016

- 28,145 licensed PNs reside in Virginia.<sup>2</sup>
- 100,702 registered nurses resides in Virginia.<sup>2</sup>

In 2015, the Virginia state received Title VIII Grant of \$5,446,254.<sup>3</sup>
