Desirée Hensel is the co-editor of Lippincott's Q and A Review for NCLEX RN (11-13th ed) and the founder and chief executive officer of Hensel Nursing Education Consulting, a business dedicated to helping solve the challenges of educating nurses in the 21st century. Her academic experience includes earning tenure at Indiana University and serving as the inaugural dean at Curry College School of Nursing in Milton, Massachusetts. Dr. Hensel's scholarship centers on curricular design, holistic evaluation, and the use of high-impact teaching strategies. Her scholarly work has been widely disseminated in peer-reviewed journals and internal venues. During the pandemic, she led efforts to create a cohesive approach to online clinical education focused on developing clinical judgement. Known for her pragmatic approach, Dr. Hensel is a sought-after speaker who lectures to faculty and students nationally and internationally about NCLEX preparation including leading workshops of testing clinical judgment and conducting mini NCLEX reviews for the National Student Nurses Association.
