Must have excellent communication and interpersonal skills, as well as, the ability to interact and communicate with all levels of management and academia (administration, faculty, staff, and students). Must have excellent time management skills and be able to perform well under pressure. Must be able to multi-task, prioritize work, and coordinate complex business events.
