NLN CERTIFICATION

The NLN offers three levels of nursing education certification: Certified Nurse Educator (CNE[®]), Certified Academic Clinical Nurse Educator (CNE[®]cl), and Certified Novice Nurse Educator (CNE[®]n). Certification establishes nursing education as a specialty area of practice and creates a means for faculty to demonstrate their expertise in this role—the mark of distinction for nursing faculty.

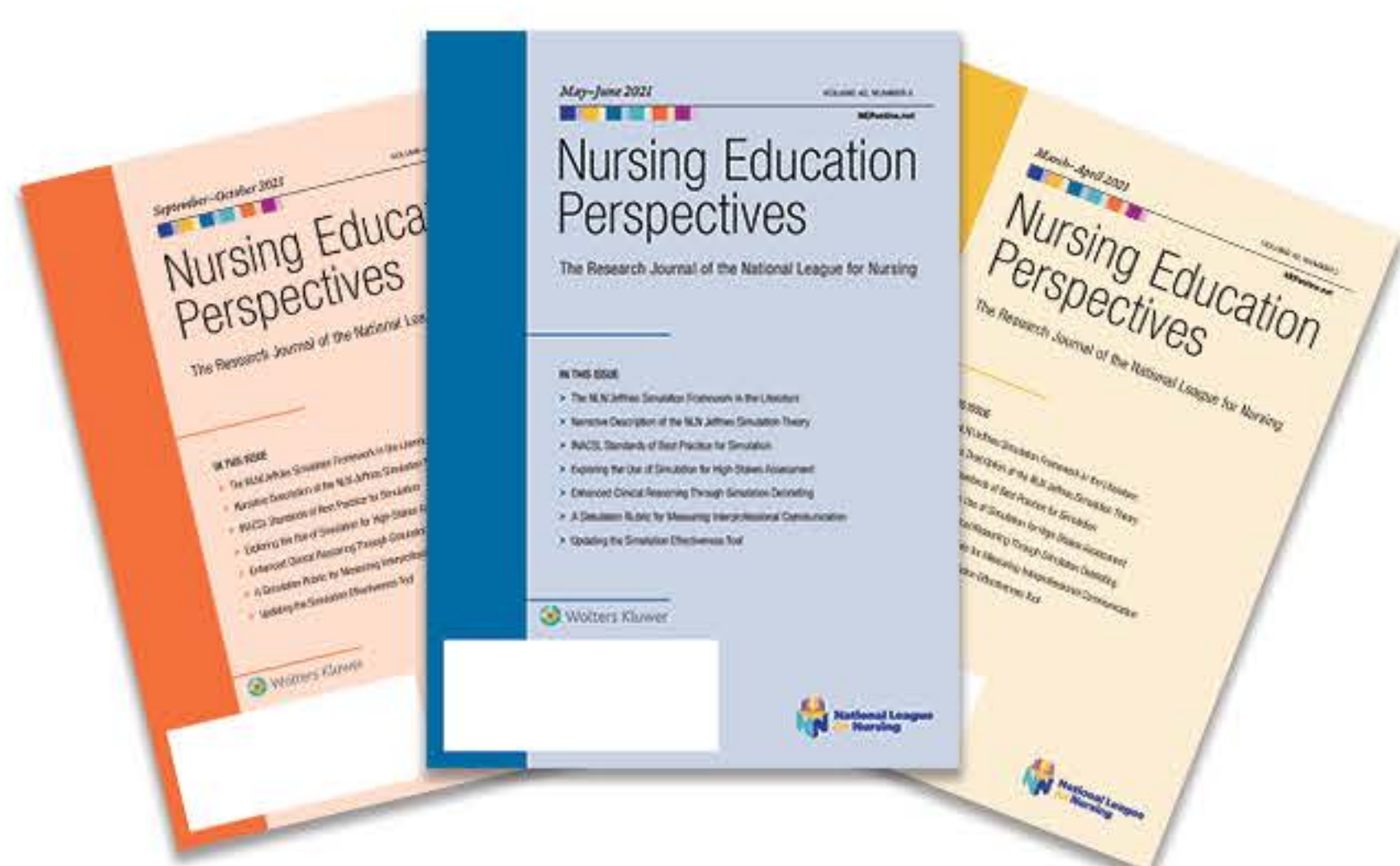
