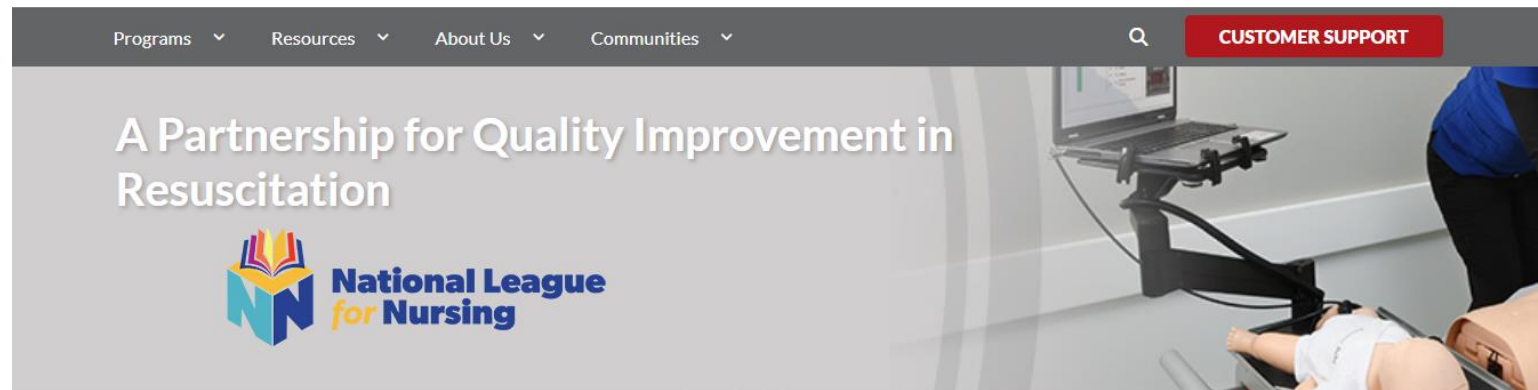

Resuscitation Quality Improvement (RQI) Policy

Completion of the American Heart Association (AHA) Resuscitation Quality Improvement (RQI) program is included as a minimum passing standard. Failure to complete AHA RQI assigned quarterly cognitive modules and skills validation may result in a semester grade of Incomplete "I" or failure.

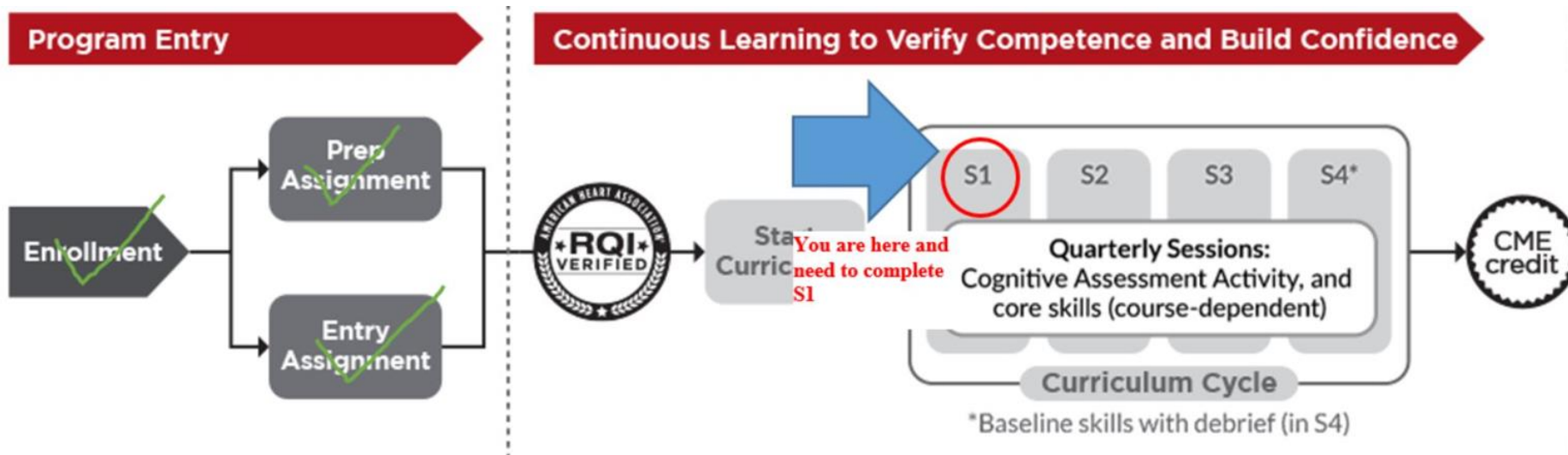
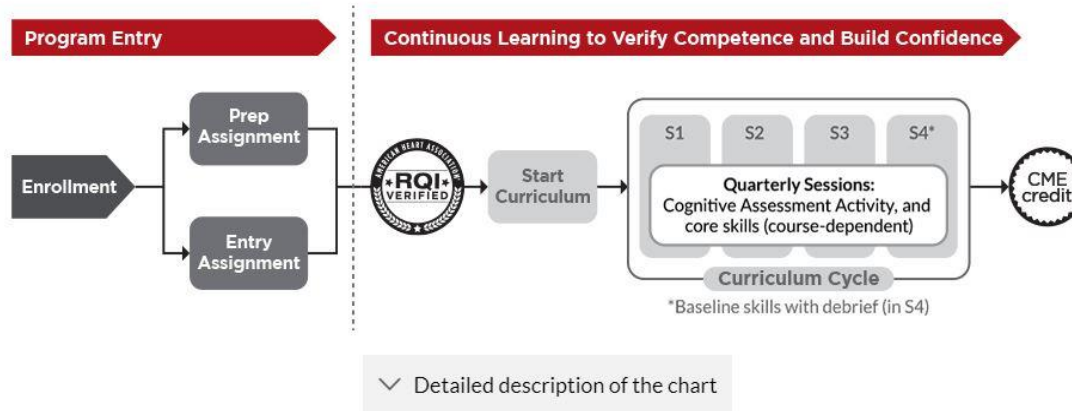

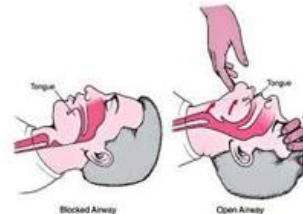

Purdue University Northwest CPR Hands-on Skills Validation Instructions

- 1) Open Drawer and remove child and adult ambu bags
- 2) Turn on computer
- 3) Log-on to Brightspace
- 4) Open RQI course
- 5) Click "Content" tab
- 6) Click "pre-assignment"
- 7) Click "manikin activity" then follow the prompts

Tips

- 1) Review proper positioning for chest compression and ventilation
- 2) During evaluation listen to the feedback provided by the computer
- 3) Look for green on the computer this will tell you if you are on track
- 4) Airway reminders:
 - Chin lift



- Positioning of the mask



- Look for chest rise
- If you are struggling with ventilation most likely you need to lift the chin or do not have a good mask seal around the face

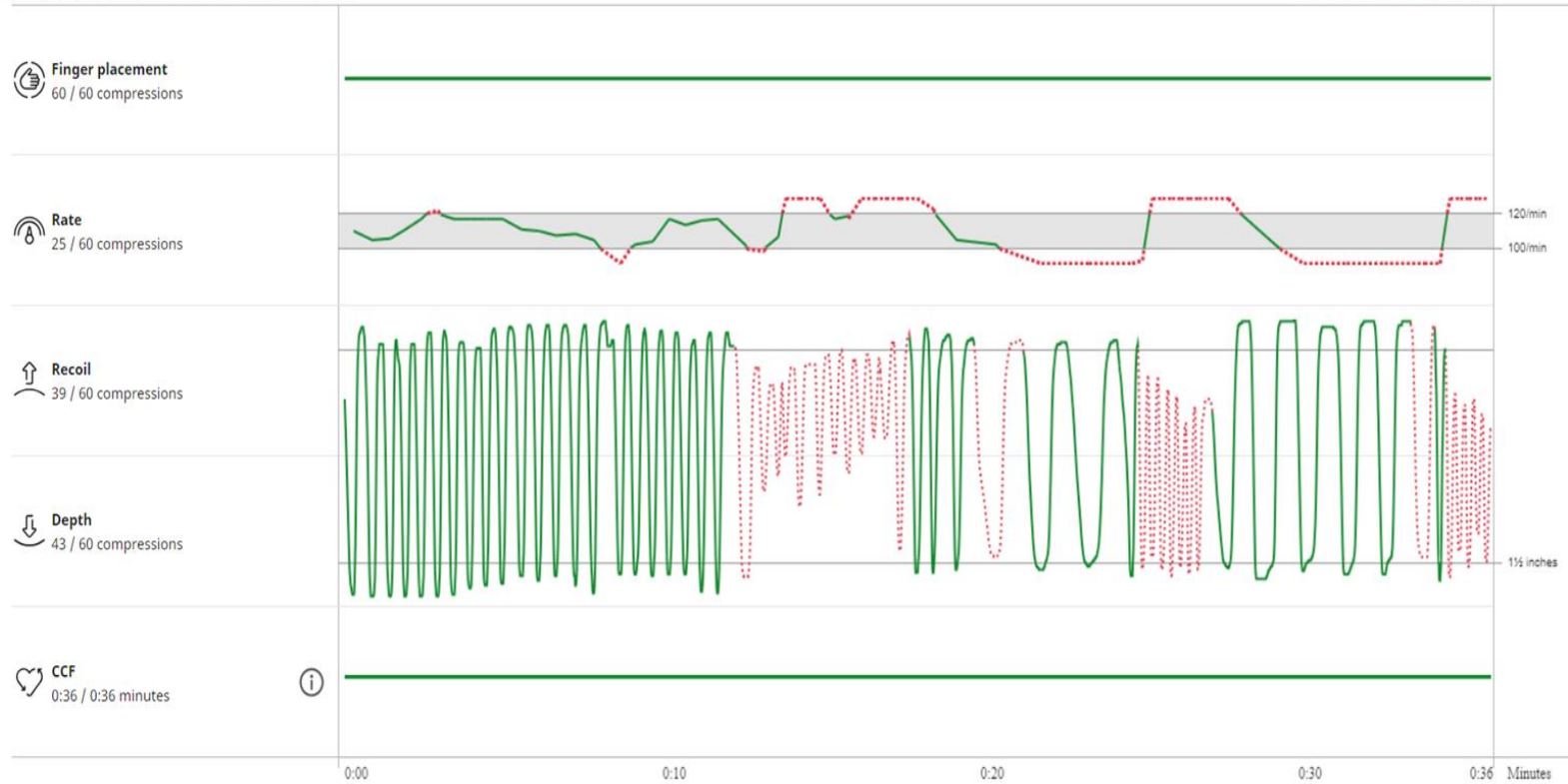

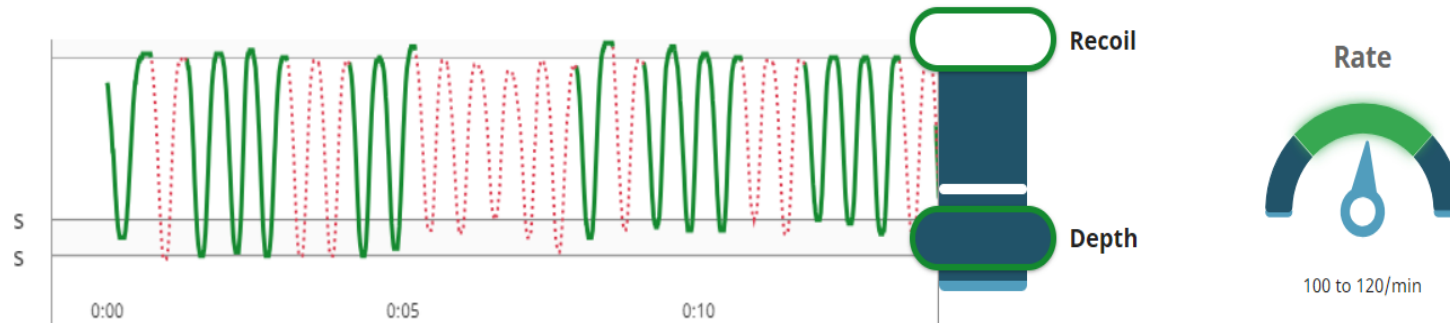

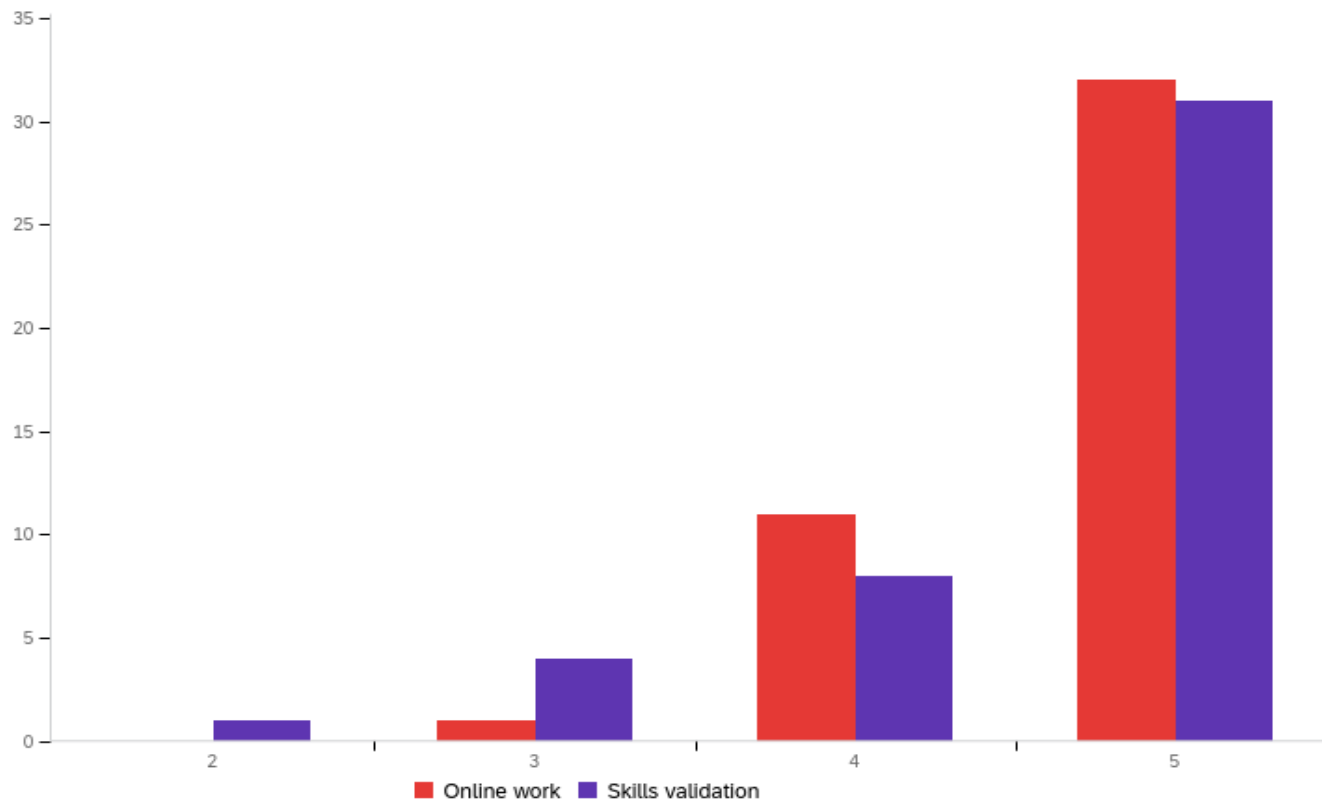


Challenges with Compliance
